NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the General Meeting of the Company (the "**GM**") will be held at 12.00 p.m. on 13 December 2017 at Richmond House, St Julian's Avenue, St Peter Port, Guernsey GY1 1GZ for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, passing the following resolutions of which resolutions 1 to 4 below shall be proposed as ordinary resolutions and resolution 5 below shall be proposed as a special resolution:


ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

1. To authorise the directors of the Company in accordance with Article 4.3 of the Articles, generally and unconditionally to issue and allot, grants rights to subscribe for, or to convert any securities into up to 2,000,000 equity securities (as defined in the Articles), pursuant to the Placing agreements entered into with Cornhill Capital Limited and Novum Securities Limited, announced on 16 November 2017.
2. To authorise the directors of the Company in accordance with Article 4.3 of the Articles, generally and unconditionally to issue and allot, grants rights to subscribe for, or to convert any securities into up to 1,500,000,000 equity securities (as defined in the Articles).
3. To authorise the directors of the Company in accordance with Article 4.3 of the Articles, generally and unconditionally to issue and allot, grants rights to subscribe for, or to convert any securities into up to 2,500,000,000 equity securities (as defined in the Articles) in order to comply with the Company's obligations under loan agreement between the Company and Katrina Clayton.
4. To authorise the directors of the Company in accordance with Article 4.3 of the Articles, generally and unconditionally to issue and allot, grants rights to subscribe for, or to convert any securities into up to 125,000,000 equity securities (as defined in the Articles) to staff, consultants and persons holding similar or equivalent positions as "equity incentives".

SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS

5. To authorise the directors of the Company, in accordance with Article 4.13 of the Articles, generally and unconditionally, to issue and allot (or sell from treasury) equity securities (as defined in the Articles) wholly for cash as if the members' pre-emption rights contained in the Articles did not apply to any such issue and allotment (or sale from treasury) pursuant to the general authority conferred on them by the ordinary resolutions numbered 1,2,3 and 4 above (as varied from time to time by the Company in general meeting) provided that, the power hereby conferred shall expire on whichever is the earlier of:
 - (i) the conclusion of the AGM of the Company held in 2018; or
 - (ii) the date falling 15 months from the date of the passing of this special resolution (unless renewed, varied or revoked by the Company prior to that date) save that the Company may, before such expiry, make offers or agreements which would or might require equity securities to be issued and allotted (or sold) after such expiry and the directors may issue and allot (or sell) equity securities in pursuance to such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the power conferred by this special resolution has expired.

Notes to the Notice of GM

1. A member may appoint one or more proxies to exercise all or any of its rights to attend, speak and, on a poll, to vote instead of him/her. A proxy need not be a member. The completion and return of a Form of Proxy will not prevent a member from attending the GM and voting in person should he/she so wish.
2. A member may appoint more than one proxy but only one proxy may attend as such and vote instead of such member at the GM.
3. Forms of Proxy if used (together with any power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which they are signed or notarially certified or in some other way approved by the Board) must be deposited at the offices of Link Market Services, PXS1, The Registry, 34 Beckenham Road, Beckenham, Kent BR3 4ZF not less than 48 hours before the time of the GM and in default will not be treated as valid.
4. In the case of joint holders, such persons shall not have the right of voting individually but shall elect one of their number to represent them and to vote whether in person or by proxy in their name. In default of such election, the person whose name stands first in the Register of Members in respect of the joint holding shall alone be entitled to vote.
